MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The following Agreement was concluded between the Rotary Club of TOROS (Rotary International District 2430 and

the Rotary Club of CETATEA TOMIS CONSTANTA (Rotary International District 2241)

Twin clubs (also called Sister Clubs) are two clubs from different Rotary International (RI) countries. By establishing strong friendship ties, both clubs aim to advance international understanding, goodwill and peace.

PURPOSE

Through a Worldwide Fellowship of business professionals, Twin Clubs unite in the ideal of service. Members of Twin Clubs team up to participate in international service projects, friendship- and cultural exchanges.

MUTUAL AGREEMENT

The parties mutually agree to exchange Club bulletins, publications and information related to their particular activities and projects.

Members of each club will consider adopting exchange, travel, education and other similar programs involving Rotarian members of the respective clubs as well as their children and grandchildren.

Each Club will register this Twin Club Agreement to their respective Twin Club District Committee chairmen.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

The initial term will be 20 years, starting from

8 April 2025

In recognition of this Twin Club relationship, each Club shall endeavour to keep its members conscious about this commitment. Anniversary of the executions of this agreement shall be observed by reminding their respective members at the first regular meeting in July of each year.

To be signed by both Presidents and kept on file by both Twin Clubs.
